COURSE CONTENT

SOCCER

The soccer course will be comprehensive, covering all elements of the game, from basic techniques through to strategy and tactics. All participants will be expected to take an active role in this element.

All participants will be given the opportunity to play in games against local opposition.

As was pioneered by the Bobby Charlton Soccer School all participants will take part in a number of Skills Challenges. These were initiated by BCSSA and have been adopted by many other famous Soccer Schools. One player from each of BCSSA courses will be selected to compete in BCSSA World International Skills Final which will take place in the Autumn. BCSSA do get many elite players visiting the school and BCSSA most famous past pupil, who won BCSSA Skills Final was David Beckham for whom BCSSA set up a trial with Manchester United.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND SOCCER

BCSSA English Language Course is specially designed to give BCSSA players a fantastic holiday and to help them enjoy and confidently use English, using it all day with other students and with native speakers in and around the campus.

Teaching approaches to modern languages has changed enormously in recent years – it's now a lot more fun and a far more rewarding experience !

BCSSA teachers will conduct the English lessons almost entirely in English – which helps students to make progress from the very first lesson and soon grow in the confidence to communicate in English in a variety of social and sporting situations. The English Language lessons wherever

possible will be tailored towards football, allowing students to study through a medium they thoroughly enjoy and in which they are both confident and knowledgeable.

Unlike most English Language Schools, at Bobby Charlton's students are encouraged to speak English all day, inside and outside classes. In this way, they not only practice their English, but also make many friends from other countries. This method has proven to be highly effective and boosts confidence.

Classes

An assessment test will be carried out on the first day to assess which level is right for each student's needs. There are five levels of general language tuition. On enrolment, students take a test to find which class is best for them. These are: Elementary, Pre-Intermediate, Intermediate, Upper-Intermediate and Advanced.

Classes are organized so that each student is with others who have a similar standard of English. There are usually 12 students in each group. All BCSSA teachers are experienced, qualified professionals, chosen for their special abilities with younger learners. BCSSA uses interactive techniques such as role play, pair work, and group work in order to maximize student participation. Students have the chance to do a lot of speaking in class, building their confidence to use the language in the throughout the day and evenings.

BCSSA English Language course consists of 20 lessons per week (15 hours).

For 2010 BCSSA is excited to be able to offer BCSSA language students the chance to enjoy conversational workshops with selected pupils from Parrswood High School to practice their oral communication skills. This will enable students to have some social conversation with British children of a similar age.

BCSSA conversational workshop is a unique opportunity for our language students to improve their conversational fluency, pronunciation and to experience the common everyday language that English people speak to their friends. This will not only improve fluency and help students sound more natural but will also help them to understand word stress, intonation and connected speech.

ACCOMMODATION

The Manchester Didsbury Travelodge Hotel is a comfortable, modern hotel in South Manchester, conveniently situated adjacent to BCSSA Parrswood Campus. It is ideally located 4.9 miles from Manchester International Airport and just 6 miles south of Manchester City centre.

The Manchester Didsbury Travelodge Hotel is a 4-story modern building

The rooms are twin or triple with modern facilities. Every room has its own en-suite bathroom housing a bath and showering facilities. There is a remote controlled TV in every room (a channel restriction will be in operation during the Residential) Also for older players there will be complimentary tea and coffee making facilities. Towels will be provided.

Living on Campus:

Laundry. Personal clothing can be washed and dried using a local launderette. These are coin-operated. It would be ideal if the children could bring enough clothing to last their stay.

Fire drills take place on a regular basis.

Damages. All rooms and common areas are regularly checked for damages, and individuals who cause damage to any property on the site will be liable for the cost of repairs.

WELFARE

BCSSA takes responsibility for student care very seriously. In fact, it's BCSSA number one priority. When you travel to BCSSA you need to be confident that everything is taken care of to ensure you are protected and safe. BCSSA campus at Parrswood Campus and the Travelodge Hotel enjoys full 24 hour CCTV coverage and 24 hour security staff. All BCSSA staff at Bobby Charlton Soccer and Sports Academy quickly work to help the players settle in and feel comfortable within their new environment. Whatever their needs, BCSSA will be there to support them during their stay in Manchester. Along with their designated coach BCSSA has a dedicated member of staff that they can speak to at anytime should they need to.

On the players first day BCSSA will go through their programme and routines and outline BCSSA health and safety procedure. BCSSA will give the students a tour of the Campus and Accommodation.

IMPORTANT

Players are required to provide a passport style photo, which may be emailed, prior to their stay and this will then be used to issue them a BCSSA Player Identification Card. This will contain the players' parents contact details and a 24hr emergency mobile phone number for BCSSA.

BCSSA has a 'Welcome Handbook' full of useful information which will be given to players upon arrival.

VALUABLES

All students are advised not to bring with them elements of personal belongings that are valuable and expensive. Insurance cover for personal belongings rests solely with the student and their family. Students are also advised to utilize the 'Bank' that BCSSA operates at all its courses, this ensures that all personal belongings are looked after. Information regarding this service will be made available on arrival.

AIRPORT MEET AND GREET TRANSFER

BCSSA provides a negotiated transfer service from Manchester International Airport to Parrswood Campus. All transfer must be pre-arranged. After collecting their luggage, students proceed through customs and into the arrivals hall. Students are then met by a representative of BCSSA who will be displaying a prominent sign. From here students will be transported to the Parrswood Campus. BCSSA would appreciate that you arrange for flights to arrive mid afternoon to ensure the students attend the welcome meeting at 6.00pm. Late flights can be accommodated at an additional cost.

It is of **vital importance** that all necessary flight details are sent to us with the booking form. BCSSA need the exact flight information, including dates, airlines, flight numbers and flight times. This service must be booked no later than four (4) weeks prior to the start of the course.

Removal of students

BCSSA keeps the rules to the minimum but certain rules must be adhered to. BCSSA have the right to request parents to remove a Student from the programme where, in the opinion of the Course Director such action is in the interest of the Student or of the programme. There will be no refund of fees for the balance of the term when such a request has been made.

The decision to request removal of the pupil from the programme and the manner and form of any curtailment is left entirely to the sole discretion of the BCSSA Course Director. Under no circumstances shall the organization be required to divulge to parents any confidential information or the identities of other students or others that have given information, which has led to the request, which the BCSSA Course Director has acquired during an investigation.
