Refund policy:

3. Outside of this period no refund can be given for cancellations received for residential courses, less than 6 weeks prior to the date of the relevant course.
4. For cancellations made earlier than this a full refund is available subject to a US\$75 administrative charge. Please note that a booking can be transferred to another person without charge.
5. All courses, activities, venues and travel arrangements are subject to change according to weather, venue availability, a satisfactory level of numbers or factors beyond MUSS control. As such, MUSS may cancel or change any courses, should this be necessary for these reasons. YOUTH PLAYER TRAINING COURSE (17-18 year olds)

This advanced, intensive course gives older players a valuable insight into the opportunities that arise by staying in the game. This focuses on teaching the fundamental techniques of the game and showing players how to master these skills. Tailor-made for junior players with a fun and friendly atmosphere, football mad kids live and breathe the game for a week. Players will learn how to practice like their heroes and can truly feel they are living the dream as a young United player.

PARENT/GUARDIANS INFORMATION

Child Welfare

MUSS considers the welfare of each and every child on MUSS courses as vitally important and MUSS need your assistance to ensure the safety and security of your child throughout their stay with MUSS.

Please ensure you provide us with all the relevant medical, emergency contact and travel information for you child at least 1 month prior to arrival.

MUSS will have a dedicated Child Welfare team on site 24 hours a day to cater for the needs of all children.

Arrival Registration

Unless you are being picked up by MUSS at Manchester Airport all children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by a named adult at registration each Sunday.

Departure

For the safety and security of its participants MUSS will only release participants under 16 years of age to named adults on departure. If you arrange an Airport Transfer with MUSS then you do not need to do this.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL MUSS ALLOW CHILDREN UNDER 16 TO LEAVE THE COURSE WITHOUT A NAMED ADULT, SO PLEASE ARRIVE PROMPTLY AT COLLECTION TIME.

These regulations are designed for the safety and welfare of children in MUSS care. Should children not be collected in accordance with MUSS requirements, the area Social Services Authority will be contacted.

International Participants

Players aged 8-18 who need a visa to access the UK need to produce their course confirmation email details to their Local British Embassy and apply for a CHILD VISITOR CATEGORY VISA. It is your responsibility to ensure that you have given yourself enough time for the visa application process.

Accommodation

Accommodation will be in dormitories of varying sizes, with toilets and showers being shared. Bed linen will be provided. **The rooms will be allocated on arrival. Should you wish to share with a friend or relative please inform MUSS on arrival.** Please note that MUSS cannot guarantee all requests of this nature, and these requests should not be made in advance of your course.

Meals

Three cooked meals are provided each day with a choice of menu always being available. Please complete the relevant section on the application form if you have any special dietary requirements.

Pocket Money

A small amount of pocket money is all that is required for purchases from the Old Trafford Megastore. MUSS recommends that all residents deposit their money and any valuables in the Soccer Schools bank for security. The bank is open throughout the week to withdraw funds.

What to Bring

You will receive a set of Manchester United Soccer Schools training kit but you will also need to bring enough football kit to last the whole week. Kit should include t-shirts, shorts, socks, tracksuit and trainers. **SHINPADS** must be worn at all times during training. The coaching will take place on grass pitches and as such football boots and astro trainers can be used. Other activities may include swimming and tennis so bring the relevant kit with you. Casual clothes are required for the evenings, as well as towels and toiletries. Only very limited laundry facilities are available so please bring enough clothing for your stay. **Please ensure that all kit including shin pads, boots and trainers are named.** Many children will possess the same replica shirts and similar boots so this will help MUSS if they get lost.

Mobile Phones

All mobile phones MUST be given in to MUSS at registration. Since many of MUSS visitors will be staying in dormitories, phones are quite disruptive to the child's room mates. This is also to prevent them getting lost, broken or being misused. Children will be able to use their mobile phone between **5.30pm - 6.30pm only** each day. The phones will then be collected back once they have been used. An emergency phone number will be available for use by parents/guardians and will be given on registration.

Other Activities

MUSS training locations offer a fantastic range of sports facilities which we will be utilising during your stay. A full range of activities will be available throughout the week. All these onsite activities are free of charge.

Insurance

MUSS recommend that all participants obtain travel insurance for personal items, and also to cover you if you are unable to attend due to illness or injury. This should also cover you should your stay be cut short due to illness or injury, as refunds will not be issued in any of these circumstances.

Departure

For the safety and security of its participants MUSS will only release participants under 16 years of age to named adults on departure. If you arrange an Airport Transfer with us then you do not need to do this.

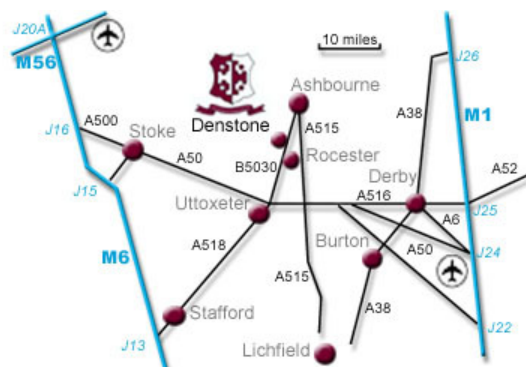

Train

Car

From UTTOXETER: Take the B5030 road towards Ashbourne and follow signs for Denstone. After approx 1 Km turn left onto the B5031. Then turn left after about 300m at signpost 'Denstone College'. Finally, turn left again onto College Road after the post office.

Directions to Old Trafford Stadium



Recommended Route. Leave the M60 Motorway at Junction 7 to join the A56 Manchester bound. Remain on the A56 following the signs for Manchester United. Turn left in to Sir Matt Busby Way. Car parking is on the right in front of the stadium OR Leave the M60 at Junction 9 and join Parkway (A5081) towards Trafford Park. At the first island take the 3rd exit onto Village Way and remain on this road until the next island (controlled by traffic lights). At this island take the second exit and then join Wharfedale Way. Turn right at the junction with Sir Matt Busby Way, car parking is on the left in front of the stadium.
